CLIMATE & WEATHER IN THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

The Cayman Islands enjoy summer like weather all year round. Lying between the latitudes of 19° and 20° North, in the far Western Caribbean, the Cayman Islands are tempered by cooling trade winds.

Temperatures reach highs of 29°C (85°F) to 32°C (90°F) during the summer months of July and August. Relative humidity varies from 68% to 92%.

Temperatures are coolest during February, ranging from 22°C (72°F) to 30°C (86°F) during the day and 17°C (64°F) to 22°C (72°F) at night. The sea temperature ranges from 25°C (78°F) to 27°C (82°F) in the winter months and from 27°C (82°F) to 30°C (86°F) in the summer.

Location

Grand Cayman and its sister islands are located just south of Cuba in the Caribbean Sea approximately 1-hour flight south from Florida, USA (Miami, Fort Lauderdale).

Edward Bodden Airfield (IATA: LYB, ICAO: MWCL), also known as Little Cayman Airport, is an airfield located on the southwest side of Little Cayman, with direct flights from Grand Cayman, Cayman Brac and Miami.

Little Cayman is the smallest and least populated of the three Cayman Islands (Grand Cayman, Cayman Brac, and Little Cayman) at 10 miles long and 1 mile wide. The close proximity to Grand Cayman, with full medical facilities and access to fresh food and resources means Little Cayman is extremely well supported, for a small tropical island.

The smallest of the three Cayman Islands, Little Cayman, is located 80 miles northeast of Grand Cayman and 5 miles west of Cayman Brac. There are 4 flights per day to Little Cayman arriving from both Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac.

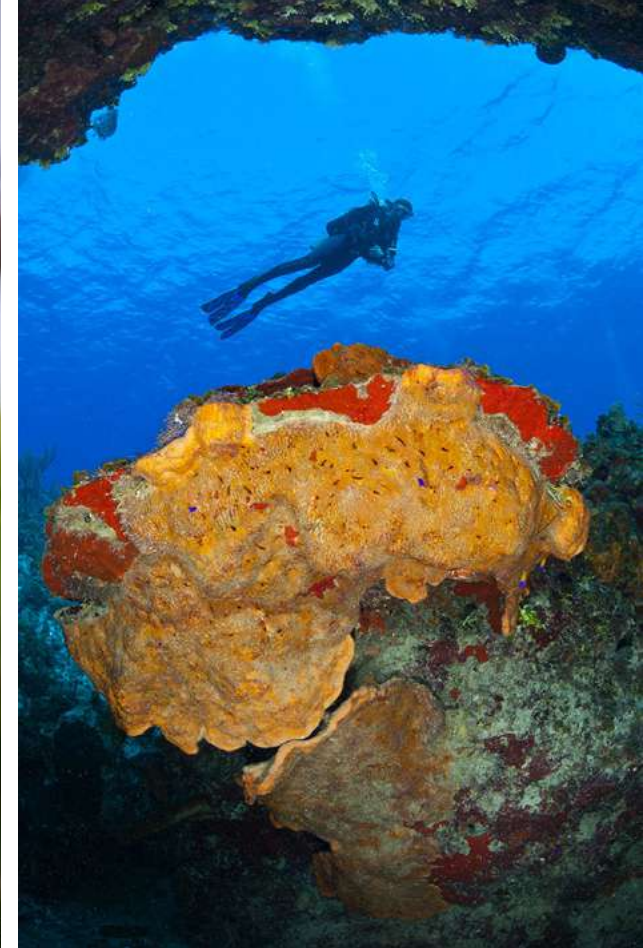


WHAT TO SEE ON LITTLE CAYMAN

You know that remote island wonderland you always see in films and read about in books? It's here. At ten miles long and one mile wide, there may be more peace and quiet per-square-inch on Little Cayman than anywhere else. Bask on empty beaches with soft sand and only the sound of the breeze rustling the palm trees. Then, take a bike or a scooter up and down the shore.

Venture to South Hole Sound Lagoon for a private swim in water that is every shade of blue. Or row out to the unofficial fourth island in Cayman. Just a kayak away off the coast of Little Cayman, Owen Island offers seascapes in their purest form, making you feel as if you were the last person on the planet.





On land, peaceful Little Cayman offers a calm, serene landscape where the bustle of the birds at the Booby Pond Nature Reserve may be the loudest commotion on land. Perhaps Little Cayman is so calm because all the activity is set aside for the fish in the surrounding reefs. Bloody Bay Wall Marine Park is one of the most popular dives in existence, after all.

With a dramatic dropoff over 5,000ft, Bloody Bay Wall gives divers the opportunity to glimpse Cayman's underwater life in a dramatic backdrop. Just 100ft below the surface, the island's native sharks, stingrays and turtles can be viewed against the stunning backdrop of Bloody Bay Wall.

LITTLE CAYMAN SERVICES

HEALTHCARE

The Little Cayman Clinic located on Spot Bay Road offers medical and dental care 5 days per week ran by a local nurse and weekly visits from doctors based on Cayman Brac.

The nurse who runs the clinic is on call 24hr 7 days offering home visits, in case of emergency the island has an ambulance service and medivac to be transported to either Grand Cayman or Cayman Brac.

PUBLIC SERVICES

POLICE SERVICE: there is a two-man police force based on Little Cayman who work under British Common Law. The police officers are easily recognisable with there uniform in a white shirt and black trousers with a red stripe.

FIRE BRIGADE: The fire crew are based at the Edward Bodden Airport where the fire hydrant is located. The crew have a fire truck and rescue boat for use in the case of an emergency.

POST OFFICE: All mail goes to a central post office located on Little Cayman, residents collect there mail from the office. Amazon also offer delivery services to the Little Cayman post office.

BANKS: The Cayman National Bank has a branch located in Blossom Village offering a 24-hour ATM.

EDUCATION

Situated on the idyllic Little Cayman, primary age students follow the full national curriculum and operate out of a specialist facility with a full time teacher and teaching assistant. Increasing use is made of ICT to link with other schools both within Cayman and other parts of the world to enhance the teaching and learning experiences for students.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Little Cayman have two internet providers Flow and Digicel giving download speeds at 512KBPS - 300MBPS. Portable internet modems are also available offering 4G internet connections.



GETTING AROUND LITTLE CAYMAN

CYCLE

Set off late in the afternoon for a gentle bicycle ride, (hotels usually offer them to guests free of charge), and follow 8 mile loop around the Island. Stop along the way at wildlife viewing stations or at a sunset viewing point. Take lots of water or even pack a snack for a picnic at one of the many unspoiled beaches along the way.

RENT A KAYAK

Explore Little Caymans mangroves or paddle your way out to Owen Island and spend the day beach combing and swimming from this uninhabited island.

HIKING

The best Little Cayman hiking trails include the Salt Rock Nature Trail which is a 3m (5km) round trip requiring a couple of hours to complete. There's also a good hike between Blossom Village and the North Coast where you'll likely encounter plenty of birds, butterflies, iguanas and orchids.

HIRE A CAR OR SCOOTER

The island's only car rental outlet is McLaughlin Enterprises, Blossom Village. Their office is located in a small shopping strip, is clearly visible from the airstrip and within easy walking distance. You can also call the company through an airport courtesy phone and ask them to pick you up.

If you fancy a little more action, it is definitely worth renting a scooter to explore the island to find things like the quaint island-style drink stand in the East End that offers complimentary refreshments, a hammock and a picnic table.





Head to Owen Island just off the southwest coast of Little Cayman, the only way to reach this islet is by sailing or kayaking across the island's calm waters, so prepare for an exciting voyage. It is famous for its clear blue waters, shallow and warm, that are perfect for snorkeling and fishing.

Once on Owen Island, you can enjoy a picnic or simply indulge in the tranquility that surrounds you. The islet doesn't have any permanent structures or residents, making it the ultimate respite. Enjoy the ambiance alone or with friends and still make it back to your resort in time for dinner.



Owen Island is also available as a wedding destination, offering the luxury of spending your special day on a private Caribbean Island.

LITTLE CAYMAN MUSEUM



Housed in new quarters, this is an impressive museum for a little island. Stop by to peruse exhibits on the history of Cayman, as well as a display of wonderful underwater photography and rotating exhibits of local artwork.

There's also an iguana habitat out back, which the museum attendant (an iguana expert) will happily show you.

LITTLE CAYMAN POINT OF SANDS



There aren't many untouched places on earth that look like Point of Sands. This secluded paradise is located on the northeastern tip of Little Cayman.

A striking combination of white sand, turquoise water and a colorful coral reef attract visitors every summer. The shallow water stretches for 4.5 meters, and then the clear sandy bottom gradually deepens.

BOOBY POND

NATURE RESERVE



Based on a land-locked saltwater lagoon with mangrove margins leading to old-growth dry forest, the Booby Pond Nature Reserve and Rookery Ramsar site provides a habitat for many types of wetland and shore birds, and a high diversity of native plants.

The most distinctive aspect of the Booby Pond is its resident colony of approximately 4,000 Red-footed Boobie.

The reserve is the only breeding site for the Red-footed Booby in the Cayman Islands and the colony is one of the largest of this species in the region. It is believed that the colony on Little Cayman now represents at least a third of its entire Caribbean and Atlantic population.

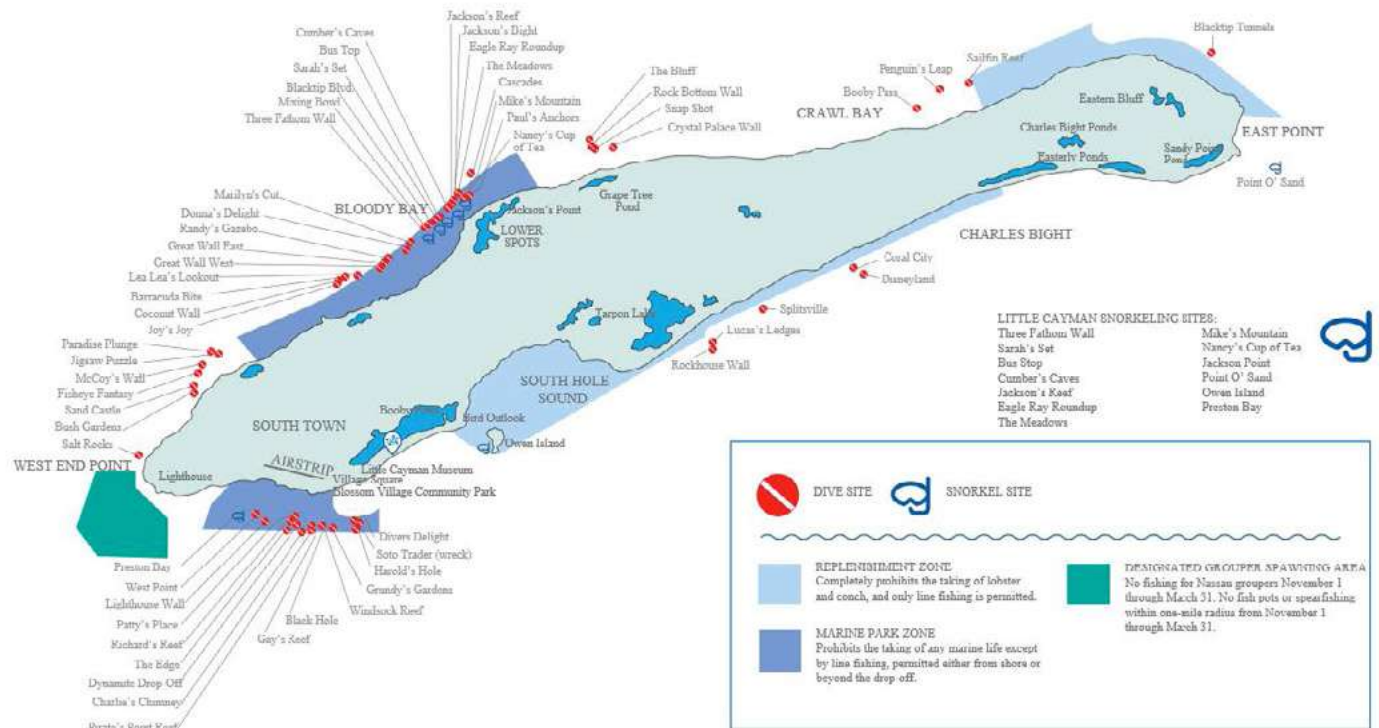




LITTLE CAYMAN DIVING

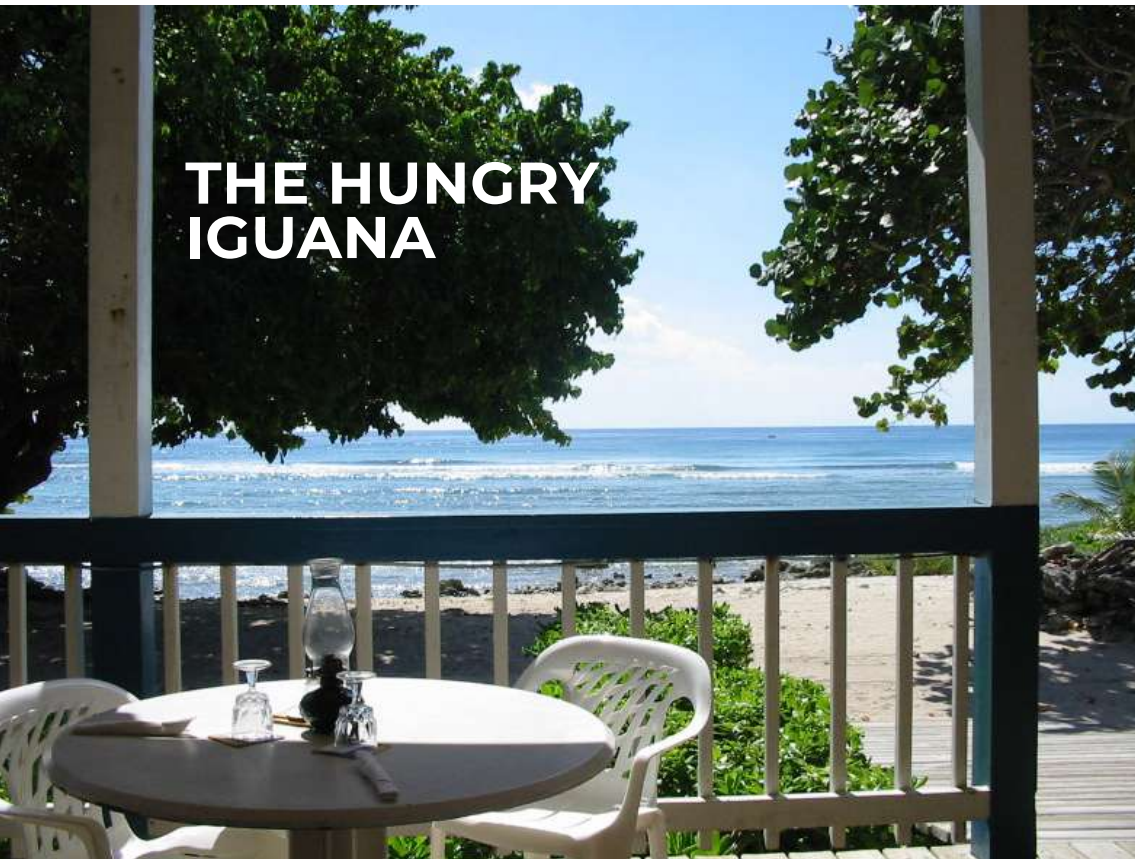


BEACH NUTS BAR
